

Minutes of the OSWEGO TOWNSHIP CEMETERIES  
ANNUAL MEETING  
April 6, 2017

The meeting of the Oswego Township Cemeteries was called to order at 9:01 A.M. by Treasurer James K. Detzler.

Township Cemetery Officials in attendance were: Treasurer, James K. Detzler; Superintendent, James Ramey; Trustees Irvin Collins and Gene McDowell, and Township Administrative Assistant, Michele Stradal.

Treasurer Detzler asked for appointment suggestions to take the place of Joyce Neu who retired.

Discussion of budget

Superintendent Ramey's report:

2 cremation vaults installed at the Oswego Township Cemetery. This season will be running electric, finishing brickwork, planters, flagpole, & landscaping. At the Pfund property/Pearce Cemetery extension we took some trees down, made a horseshoe drive extending the existing driveway which should be settled in 1-2 years. He will be getting a surveyor to lay out graves. I have a list of people who want new plots. Plaque for Pfund Addition ordered. Purchased new 734 mower which saves mowing time. Would like to update some equipment ie. Leaf Vac and 16' landscape trailer. As of 6/1/17 we will be mowing all 6 cemeteries ourselves. 500 series tractor bad oil leak, fixed temporarily without guarantee for back up and buy some time, and we will run it until it quits. This tractor has a smaller deck that will fit between graves and will need to be replaced when it quits. Vaults are sold for \$800.00 each, hold 2 urns, and includes the open and close of the vault. I would like to in time, with the profits from these vaults, do another set of vaults at the Pfund property, where the house used to sit, as the basement foundation is still there and we can't put plots there. This will also give people a choice of where they want to be.
