

## Minutes of the Oswego Township

### SPECIAL MEETING

November 10, 2018

The special meeting of the Oswego Township was called to order at 10:00 AM by Supervisor Brian LeClercq. The pledge of allegiance to the U.S flag was given by all in attendance.

Township officials in attendance were: Supervisor Brian LeClercq, Trustees: Diane Selmer, Bill Small and Allyson Jacobsen. Also, present were Clerk Ken Holmstrom and Attorney Karl Ottosen. Trustee Stanley, Highway Commissioner Robert Rogerson and Township Assessor Brian Hauser were absent. There were 6 Oswego Township residents in attendance.

Supervisor LeClercq opened the meeting with public comments. No one wish to comment.

Supervisor LeClercq closed the public comment section of the meeting.

#### New Business:

Supervisor LeClercq announced that Trustee Donna Stanley applied for the new position within the Highway Department and has been selected to fill that vacancy. She has submitted her resignation from her Trustee position. Trustee Jacobsen motioned to accept Trustee Stanley's resignation, second by Trustee Selmer. Roll call: Jacobsen, Selmer, Small and LeClercq voted to accept. Motion carried.

Supervisor LeClercq asked for a motion to go to Closed Session for the purpose of Appointment, Employment, Compensation, Discipline, Performance, or Dismissal of Personal [5 ILCS 120/2(c) (l)]. Trustee Selmer motioned to go into Closed Session second by Trustee Small. All Trustee's present voted to go into closed session. The meeting went into closed session at 10:18.

The special meeting of the Oswego Township reconvened at 10:35AM. In attendance were Trustee Jacobsen, Selmer, Small, and Supervisor LeClercq. Also, present was Attorney Karl Ottosen, and Clerk Holmstrom.


