STORM SEWERS

This Department has been actively repairing and replacing storm sewer lines and catch basins for the past 14 years. We have replaced approximately 150 catch basins along with the installation of bicycle safe grates. This has improved drainage, reduced downstream pollution and increased public safety. Please remember that all storm drains eventually flow to the local creeks and rivers, so **PLEASE DO NOT DUMP ANYTHING into the street grates.** Thank you.

We will have a **one time** "Spring Clean Up" starting the week of **May 6th**. Have your **leaves only** at your curb in grass by 7:00 am. We will only make one pass by your house sometime that week. **Have Piles ACCESSIBLE please!**

2019 Brush Pick-Up dates, one week each month, starting on:

April 22nd, May 27th, June 24th, July 22nd, August 26th, September 23rd, October 21st

When: Please have brush placed at the curb **by 7:00 A.M. Monday morning** to ensure pick-up. Brush pick-up will take place the last full week of every month from April-October. We will only make ONE pass by your house each month.

How: Laid as neatly as possible with the **cut ends toward the street** and parallel to each other. Please keep piles out of the street and gutter. During inclement weather, this can clog the storm drain covers and will cause flooding.

What is acceptable: Limbs over 2 feet long, longer the better, and no larger than 5 inches in diameter. The brush program is for the trimming and pruning of trees, not for the removal of whole trees from the property. Tied bundles (twine only)

What is not acceptable: short clippings, root balls, bags of branches, or bushes. Please do not place thorny tree branches inside piles. Place these branches next to the larger pile and our crews will take special care with them.

***WE WOULD APPRECIATE KEEPING BRUSH PILES TO A MINIMUM. MAXIMUM PILE SIZE IS 3' X 12'.**

The brush program is for trimming & pruning of trees, not the removal of whole trees from the property.

Remember, storm drains run to creeks and rivers, so PLEASE keep our environment clean – do not dump into street. THANK YOU! Check our website for water reports.

Road resurfacing and repair, Storm sewer grate / tile cleaning & repair, Curb and sidewalk repair and replace, Farm entrance repair, replace and expand, Street sweeping, Brush pickup and leaf pickup, Tree removal and tree trimming, maintaining country ditches, Painting School Crosswalks, Maintaining right of ways in BH & Shore Heights, Picking up debris in ditches in the OTWP, maintain 70 miles of road and 36 miles of right of way ditches in the country, A one pass by “spring leaf pick up” (TBA), The removal of Road Kill, Sign maintenance throughout the OTWP, Permitting agency for contractors.
