

Minutes of the Oswego Township

REGULAR MEETING

April 9, 2019

The meeting of the Oswego Township was called to order at 6:30 P.M by Supervisor Brian LeClercq. The pledge of allegiance to the U.S flag was given by all in attendance.

Township officials in attendance were: Supervisor Brian LeClercq, Trustees: Michael Bidegain, Allyson Jacobsen, Diane Selmer and Bill Small. Clerk Ken Holmstrom, Highway Commissioner Robert Rogerson and Township Assessor Brian Hauser were also present. Attorney Flaherty was present along with Officer Novak from the Kendall County Sheriff's Department. There were 11 Oswego Township residents in attendance including staff Michelle Stradal and Donna Stanley.

Supervisor LeClercq opened the public comment section of the meeting:

Linda Seyler spoke on the weed ordinance. She has been in violation of this ordinance and is opposed to the ordinance. She does not think her yard violates the ordinance and invited the board to stop by and look at her yard.

Virginia Lake voiced her opinion on the Parking ordinance and her objection to its approval.

Judy Bush also commented on the Parking ordinance and also was opposed to its approval.

With no further comments, Supervisor LeClercq closed the public comment.

Supervisor LeClercq opened the meeting for public comments on the 2019 – 2020 Township Budget & Appropriation Ordinance. Hearing no comments he closed the public comment section.

Supervisor LeClercq opened the meeting for public comment on the Road District 2019 – 2020 Budget and Appropriation ordinance. There were no comments made on this ordinance. Supervisor LeClercq closed the public comment section.

Motion to approve the bills made by Trustee Selmer, second by Trustee Bidegain. A roll call vote was held by Clerk Holmstrom. Trustee Small, Bidegain, Selmer, Jacobsen and LeClercq voted yes. Motion passed.

Supervisor LeClercq asked for approval of the March 12, 2019 meeting minutes. Motion by Bidegain to approve the minutes. Second by Trustee Small. All Trustees present voted to approve the meeting minutes of 3-12-2019.

Supervisor LeClercq asked for discussion and or approval of the Township 2019 – 2020 Budget and Appropriation ordinance # 2019-02. Trustee Jacobsen motion to approve seconded by Trustee Selmer. Roll call vote Bidegain, Jacobsen, Selmer, Small and LeClercq all voted in favor of the motion. Motion carried.

Supervisor LeClercq next asked for discussion and or approval on the Road District 2019 – 2020 Budget and Appropriation ordinance # 2019-03. Trustee Small motioned to approve the ordinance # 2019 – 03, seconded by Trustee Bidegain. Roll call vote Bidegain, Jacobsen, Selmer, Small and LeClercq all voted in favor of the motion. Motion carried.

Trustee Selmer reported on her continued meetings and work on the garbage and recycling of waste.

Highway Commissioner Rogerson gave his report. A copy of the report is attached to and becomes part of these minutes.

Township Assessor's report –He reported that they are on a quadrennial review program where they reassess properties in 4 year increments.

Supervisor Report – Supervisor LeClercq reported that this Saturday April 13, 2019 at 11:00AM is a ground breaking ceremony for the Veteran's Serenity Park. Located on Adams Street across from the old Greenhouse.

Old Business: Update from Brett Mitchell from Ethos on the progress at 84 Templeton Drive on units 102 and 103.

New Business:

Discussion and possible action of Resolution # 2019 – 04 approving contract to purchase property at 99 Boulder Hill Pass. Trustee Small motion to adopt resolution # 2019 – 04. Trustee Selmer seconded the motion. Roll call vote; Trustee's Bidegain, Jacobsen, Selmer, Small and Supervisor LeClercq voted in favor of the motion. Motion carried.

Supervisor LeClercq asked for a vote to increase the General Assistance flat grant rate to \$304 per DHS standards. Trustee Small motioned to approve the flat rate of \$304. Trustee Bidegain seconded this motion. All Trustee's present voted to approve this motion.

Supervisor LeClercq next opened for discussion and asked for a motion to file a legal objection to the proposed Kendall County Zoning ordinance 19 – 07 regarding the parking of Unoccupied Recreation Vehicles, Trailers and Mobile Homes. Trustee Small made a motion to File the objection; seconded by Selmer. All Trustee's present voted to approve the filing of the objection.

There was not a reason to go into closed session tonight.

Trustee Jacobsen motioned to adjourn the meeting, second by Trustee Small. Meeting adjourned at 7:20pm.
