2019 Brush Pick-Up Dates:

April 22nd, May 27th, June 24th, July 22nd
August 26th, September 23rd, & October 21st

When: Please have brush placed at the curb by 7:00 A.M. Monday morning to ensure pick-up. Brush pick-up will take place the last full week of every month from April-October. We will only make ONE PASS by your house EACH MONTH. Please make sure that vehicles are not parked within 20 feet of the pile in either direction or your pile will be left behind.

How: Laid as neatly as possible with the **cut ends toward the street** and parallel to each other. Please keep piles out of the street and gutter. During inclement weather, this can clog the storm drain covers and will cause flooding.

What is acceptable: Limbs over 2 feet long, the longer the better, and no larger than 5 inches in diameter. The brush program is for the trimming and pruning of trees, not for the removal of whole trees from the property. For tied bundles please use twine only

What is not acceptable: short clippings, root balls, bags of branches, or bushes. Please do not place thorny tree branches inside piles. Place these branches next to the larger pile and our crews will take special care with them.

MAXIMUM PILESIZE PER PROPERTY ISB FEET HIGHX 12 FEET LONG.

The brush program is for TRIMMING & PRUNING of trees,
NOT the removal of whole trees from the property.

LEAF VACUUMING

Leaf vacuuming service for unincorporated Oswego Township, including homes in Boulder Hill, Shore Heights, Marina Terrace and residential country areas. If you do live in a residential country area please email us at mailbox@oswegotownship.org, or call in to the office at (630) 264-4587 to report that you have leaves in need of vacuuming and we will come out at the end of the current round. We will pick up leaves at least 4 times during the season each year.

Please make sure that parked cars are not directly in front of the pile, or parked within 20 feet of the pile in either direction. This will result in your leaf pile being left. We will only make one pass by your house each time we are scheduled to pick up leaves. Please make sure that piles only contain leaves and not any foreign objects; branches, grass and yard waste do not count as leaves, they will clog our vacuums and will be left behind. Please try to rake your leaves away from mailboxes and tree trunks whenever possible and into long narrow rows from lot line to lot line. Please keep your leaf piles out of the street and gutter. During inclement weather, this can clog the storm drain covers and will cause flooding. We ask that you please be kind and courteous to the men working on leaf vacuuming. If you have a complaint or need to speak with a crew member please motion to them and do not approach the machine or moving truck. This is for the citizens and our crew member's safety. The leaf vacuuming program specific start dates vary from year to year. So please check the website, or call the office for the exact start and end dates. However, for general information we usually start leaf collection during middle to late October depending on the season.

We usually end our leaf collection the week after Thanksgiving weekend (weather permitting).

SEE FULL ORDINANCE OF THE WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS ONLINE AT www.oswegotownship.com ORDINANCE NO. RD 2018- 10

No person shall park or leave standing or unattended a motor vehicle upon any such street or part of street or alley during or after a snowfall in which there is an accumulation of two inches of snow or more. This parking prohibition shall remain in effect until such time as the street or alley has been plowed or the snow has been removed from the lane of traffic nearest the curb. When an unattended motor vehicle is found parked or stopped in violation of the restrictions, the law enforcement officer finding such vehicle shall take its registration number and may take other information displayed on the vehicle that may identify its user and shall conspicuously affix to such vehicle a traffic citation or the officer may remove such vehicle from a road to the nearest garage or other place of safety, or to a garage designated or maintained by law enforcement during snow removal operations of the township on such roads, streets, alleys, or highways within the Highway Commissioner's jurisdiction. Whenever a law enforcement officer removes a vehicle from a road as authorized by this Ordinance, the expense of such removal and storage in such garage, place of safety, or garage designated or maintained by law enforcement shall be paid by the owner or operator of the vehicle in addition to any other penalties imposed here or by this chapter. Violators of this Ordinance may be assessed a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00). Please note signs are not required to be posted on all streets for this ordinance to be inforced!
