## OSWEGO TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT LIVE MENDALL COUNTY

An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for Oswego Township Road District Kendall County, Illinois, for the tax year 2019, collectable in 2020.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Oswego Township. Kendall County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Highway Commissioner of Oswego Township Road District on November 5th, 2019 does hereby determine and declare that the sum of

Two Million Five Hundred Twenty Nine Thousand, Two Hundred Thirty Eight Dollars (\$2,529,238.00) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Road District as that property is assessed and equalized. in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Road District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

for the year 2019.
