**A RESOLUTION
PROVIDING FOR AND REQUIRING THE SUBMISSION OF A
PUBLIC QUESTION TO ABOLISH THE ROAD DISTRICT, TO BE
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MARCH 17, 2020**

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Township of Oswego, Kendall County, Illinois (the "Township") is a township duly organized under the laws of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Trustees deems it advisable and in the best interests of the Township and its residents to abolish the Oswego Road District Division pursuant to Section 6-134 of the Illinois Highway Code;

WHEREAS, the Township will assume all rights and responsibilities of the Road District upon its abolishment;

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined by the Board that abolition of the Road District shall not be detrimental to the continued operation of the Township;

WHEREAS, the Township is authorized to abolish the Road District, by submitting a proposition to the voters of the Township as provided by Section 6-134 of the Illinois Highway Code, to be approved by a majority of the voters at a general election or consolidated election; and

WHEREAS, the Board hereby deems it advisable, necessary, and in the best interests of the Township that the Proposition authorizing the Township to abolish the Road District be submitted to the voters of the Township at an election to be held and conducted in accordance with the general election laws.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Oswego Township, Kendall County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The Township Board finds and determines the foregoing Recitals to be true and correct, and said Recitals are incorporated herein as if written out here in full.

Section 2: That the following proposition shall be submitted to the voters of the Township at the General Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, March 17, 2020, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on said day (the "Election"):

Shall the Road District of the Township of Oswego be abolished with all the rights, powers, duties, assets, property, liabilities, obligations, and responsibilities being assumed by the Township of Oswego?

Section 3: That the Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established in accordance with the general election laws of the State of Illinois by the Kendall County Clerk (the "Election Authority") for voters of the Township at the Election.

Section 4: That Notice of the Election (the "Notice") shall be given in accordance with the general election laws of the State of Illinois by the Election Authority by (i) publishing the Notice once in a local community newspaper having general circulation in the Township not more than sixty (60) days nor less than ten (10) days prior to the date of the Election; and (ii) posting a copy of the Notice at least ten (10) days before the date of the Election at the principal office of the Election Authority, as required by Section 12-5 of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "Election Code").

Section 5: That not less than ten (10) days before the date of the Election, the Clerk of the Board shall post a copy of the Notice at the principal office of the Township.

Section 6: That it is hereby found and determined that the Ledger-Sentinel is a local community newspaper having general circulation in the Township as required by Section 12-5 of the Election Code.

Section 7: That said Notice shall appear over the name or title of the Election Authority and shall be substantially in the following form:

Shall the Road District of the Township of Oswego be abolished with all the rights, powers, duties, assets, property, liabilities, obligations, and responsibilities being assumed by the Township of Oswego?

The polls will be open at 6:00 a.m. and continue to be open until 7:00 p.m. on that day.

Section 9: That the Election shall be conducted by the election judges appointed
by the Election Authority to act in the voting precincts at which said proposition will be
submitted to the voters of the Township.

Section 10: That the Clerk of the Board shall, not less than seventy-nine (79) days before the Election, certify to the Election Authority the proposition as hereinabove set forth to be submitted to the voters of the Township at the Election. Such certification shall include the form of the public question to be placed on the ballot, the date on which the public question was initiated by the adoption of this Resolution, and a certified copy of the Resolution, and shall be substantially in the form of **EXHIBIT A** of this Resolution.

Section 11: That the Election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof duly canvassed, all in the manner and the time provided by law.

Section 12: The Township Clerk shall keep available a copy of this Resolution subsequent to its adoption for inspection by any interested party in the Township office.

Section 13: If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

Section 14: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as required by law.


