Leaf Pickup Starts

Approximately October 12!!!

Oswego Township will begin leaf pick-up operations as a continuous process until the last week of pickup unless further needed

The last week of pickup will begin on November 30.

STORM DEBRIS

After a storm, what am I supposed to do with the debris in my yard?

Please call the Road District if there are trees down in the street or the Right of Way. Pick up the branches that have fallen in and around your property and place them next to the concrete curb or sidewalk with the cut or larger ends facing the street. Longer branches are better. If you wish to bundle the branches, please use twine only. The Road District will only collect the brush, not the twigs and leaves that have fallen.

You can mulch or bag your twigs and leaves and call your refuse hauler to see if they can take them. Or keep them in bags by your house (not in the Right of Way) until the next Road District leaf pickup.

STORM SEWERS

This Department has been actively repairing and replacing storm sewer lines and catch basins for the past 14 years. We have replaced approximately 150 catch basins along with the installation of bicycle safe grates. This has improved drainage, reduced downstream pollution and increased public safety. Please remember that all storm drains eventually flow to the local creeks and rivers, so

PLEASE DO NOT DUMP ANYTHING into the street grates.

Township Parking Snow Ordinance

Oswego Township has implemented a new snow ordinance to prohibit parking on Township roads during snow events of 2” or more of accumulation. This ordinance will allow the Oswego Township Road District the ability to clean the streets properly, efficiently and safely for our buses, garbage & emergency trucks without any vehicles hindering this process. Road resurfacing and repair, storm sewer grate / tile cleaning & repair, curb and sidewalk repair and replace, farm entrance repair, replace and expand, street sweeping, brush pickup and leaf pickup, tree removal and tree trimming, storm clean up, maintaining country ditches, painting school crosswalks, maintaining right of ways in BH & Shore Heights, shouldering roads, picking up debris in ditches in the OTWP, maintain 70 miles of road and 36 miles of right of way ditches in the country, a one pass by “spring leaf pick up” (TBA), the removal of road kill, sign maintenance throughout the OTWP, permitting agency for contractors.
