**TAX LEVY ORDINANCE
2020-11
OSWEGO TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT**

An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for Oswego Township Road District Kendall County, Illinois, for the tax year 2020, collectable in 2021.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Oswego Township,
Kendall County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Highway Commissioner of Oswego Township Road District on December 8th, 2020 does hereby determine and declare that the sum of Two Million Five Hundred Twenty Nine Thousand, Two Hundred Thirty Eight Dollars (\$2,529,238.00) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Road District as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Road District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

General Road and Bridge Fund,
Permanent Road Fund
Equipment and Building Fund

for the year 2020.

SECTION 2: That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:

SECTION 4: That the Board of Trustees does hereby certify that the amount levied herein is necessary to be raised by taxation for road purposes for Oswego Township Road District.

SECTION 5: That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such finding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 6: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.

**TRUTH IN TAXATION
CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE
(35 ILCS 200/18-90)**

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of Oswego Township, and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Sections 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

- 1) The Taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting requirements of the Truth in Taxation Law.
