

Minutes of the Oswego Township

REGULAR MEETING

May 11, 2021

APPROVED 6-8-21

The meeting of the Oswego Township was called to order at 6:30 P.M by Supervisor Brian LeClercq. The meeting was held at 99 Boulder Hill Pass, Montgomery, Illinois. During this time of Covid-19 the meeting had to allow for social distancing and the meeting was available to attend online through Zoom. The pledge of allegiance to the U.S flag was given by all in attendance.

Township officials in attendance in person were: Supervisor Brian LeClercq, Trustees in person were Allyson Jacobsen and Diane Selmer. Clerk Ken Holmstrom, Assessor Brian Hauser and Rob DeLong were present in person. Trustee Small attended via zoom. Deputy Sheriff Casey was present via Zoom. Trustee Bidegain, Highway Commissioner Rogerson and Donna Stanley were absent for the meeting. Twenty Township residents attended in person.

Supervisor LeClercq mentioned that a quorum was present in person. The Township is allowed to hold a legal meeting and Trustees on zoom are allowed to vote because of a government order by Governor Pritzker.

Supervisor LeClercq asked for approval of the April 13, 2021 meeting minutes. Motion by Trustee Selmer to approve the minutes. Second by Trustee Jacobsen. Trustees Jacobsen, Selmer, Small and Supervisor LeClercq voted to approve the minutes of 4-11-2021 as reported. Motion carried.

Trustee Selmer – She reported that she reviewed the bank reconciliations for March and April.

Trustee Small – He reported that he also reviewed the bank reconciliations for March and April. He also reported that this was his last meeting after 28 years of service to the Township.

Supervisor LeClercq opened up public comment session. Gary Eagleton thanked Bill Small for his years of service. He also thanked Brian LeClercq for his service.


No one else wished to speak, so Supervisor LeClercq closed the public comment session.

Trustee Selmer motioned to approve, second by Trustee Small. Roll Call: Trustees Jacobsen, Selmer, Small and Supervisor LeClercq voted to approve. Motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, Trustee Jacobsen motioned to adjourn, second by Trustee Selmer. Roll Call: Trustee's Jacobsen, Selmer, Small and Supervisor LeClercq voted to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 6:45PM.
