TAX LEVY ORDINANCE 2023-09 OSWEGO TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT



An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for Oswego Township Road District Kendall County, Illinois, for the tax year 2023, collectable in 2024.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Oswego Township,
Kendall County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Highway Commissioner of Oswego Township Road District on December 12th, 2023 does hereby determine and declare that the sum of Two Million Six Hundred Eighty Three Thousand. One Hundred, Ninety Six Dollars (\$2,683,196.00) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Road District as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Road District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

General Road and Bridge Fund, Permanent Road Fund Equipment and Building Fund

for the year 2023.

SECTION 2: That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:

SECTION 6: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption, as provided by law.
