

Minutes of the Oswego Township

REGULAR MEETING

April 09, 2024

The meeting of the Oswego Township was called to order at 6:30 P.M by Supervisor Joe West. The meeting was held at 99 Boulder Hill Pass, Montgomery, Illinois. The pledge of allegiance to the U.S flag was given by all in attendance.

Township officials in attendance were Supervisor West, Trustees Bush, Helgeson, Sawicki and Selmer. Also present were Clerk Holmstrom and Highway Commissioner Ainsworth. Lynn Cullick, Rob Delong, Frank Carney and Jim Zimmerman were present. Assessor Hauser was excused from this meeting. The Deputy Sheriff was present. Thirteen residents were present. Supervisor West stated that a quorum was present.

Supervisor West asked if there were any corrections to the Minutes from 3-12-2024. Trustee Selmer motioned to approve the minutes of 3-12-2024, second by Trustee Helgeson. Roll call: Trustee Bush, Helgeson, Sawicki, Selmer and Supervisor West motioned to approve. Motion carried.

Trustee Report:

Trustee Bush reviewed the quarterly Senior reports. She attended senior lunches and reviewed the account reconcilements through 3-31-2024.

Trustee Helgeson – He attended the first meeting of the Capital Improvement project for the Oswego Senior Center. He also attended Oswego Chamber events and the Downtown Oswego Business meeting. He is also a newly appointed member of the Oswego Economic Development Committee.


Old Business: Discussion on the Contract for the Triad.
