The meeting of the Oswego Township was called to order at 6:30 P.M by Supervisor Joe West. The meeting was held at 99 Boulder Hill Pass, Montgomery, Illinois. The pledge of allegiance to the U.S flag was given by all in attendance.

Township officials in attendance were Supervisor West, Trustees Bush, Helgeson, Sawicki and Selmer. Also present were Clerk Holmstrom and Highway Commissioner Ainsworth. Lynn Cullick, Rob Delong and Jim Zimmerman were present. Assessor Hauser was excused from this meeting. The Deputy Sheriff was unable to attend. One resident was present. Supervisor West stated that a quorum was present.

Supervisor West asked if there were any corrections to the Minutes from 5-14-2024. Trustee Helgeson motioned to approve the minutes of 5-14-2024, second by Trustee Sawicki. Roll call: Trustee Bush, Helgeson, Sawicki, Selmer and Supervisor West motioned to approve. Motion carried.

Trustee Report:

Trustee Bush reported that she attended a few senior lunches, and she had a discussion with Michelle Bergeron on the senior Capital Campaign. She also reviewed the bank recons through 5-31-2024.

Trustee Helgeson – He talked about his participation in serving on the senior capital campaign committee. He also works with the downtown Oswego business district.

Trustee Sawicki – She stated that she has talked with Michelle Bergeron regarding youth programming at the Community Center.

Trustee Selmer – Stated that she reviewed the account reconcilments through 5-31-2024. Attended the Triad Town Hall meeting. She discussed activities available through Triad. She also discussed the Triad picnic scheduled for June 24, 2024.

Clerk Report: He stated that he attended the Oswego Chamber Board meeting, the Oswego Fire Department Board meeting and the Oswego Economic Development Committee meeting.

Old Business: Results of review of the closed session meeting minutes, from the May meeting review. Trustee Helgeson motioned to keep the minutes from 4-14-2020 closed, second by Trustee Sawicki. Roll call: Bush, Helgeson, Sawicki, Selmer and Supervisor West vote in favor. Motion carried.

YORKVILLE – The Illinois State Police (ISP) Division of Criminal Investigation Trafficking Enforcement Bureau arrested three individuals during a two-day human trafficking enforcement operation in the Yorkville area of Kendall County on June 26-27, 2024. The operation focused on identifying individuals seeking to engage in commercial sex acts.

As a result of the operation, the following individuals were arrested and charged:

- Nathanael Beckley (34) of Bolingbrook, IL – Traveling to Meet a Child (Class 3 Felony)
- Salvo Campagna (39) of Plano, IL – Indecent Solicitation a Child (Class 3 Felony), Traveling to Meet a Child (Class 3 Felony), and Solicitation to Meet a Child (Class 4 Felony)
- Marcus Ramirez (26) of Sandwich, IL – Indecent Solicitation a Child (Class 3 Felony), Traveling to Meet a Child (Class 3 Felony), and Solicitation to Meet a Child (Class 4 Felony)
